20TH ANNUAL REUNION LATINA

Hispanic/Latinos make up 18.4% of the more than 19.5 million NYS residents and make up 29% of New York City's population. Hispanics/Latinos are the largest racial/ethnic minority population in the United States (U.S.). About 1 in 6 people living in the U.S. are Hispanic/Latino (almost 57 million). By 2035, it is estimated that this ratio could be nearly 1 in 4. Evidence shows that Latino health care needs are largely unmet and encounter barriers to health care access: lack of health insurance, transportation, underutilization of preventive health services, and limited availability of linguistic and culturally competent services.

In New York State, 32% of people living with HIV are Latino, at a rate 5.7 times higher than the rate for Whites. There are groups more highly impacted: Latino MSM (with alarming rates for YMSM), women, IVDU and transgender individuals. Knowing this, Latinos are being connected to care at a much later stage of HIV diagnosis or more likely to be diagnosed with AIDS. The HIV epidemic continues to disproportionately affect the Hispanic/Latino population, especially Hispanic/Latino MSM. Hispanics/Latinos represented about 17% of the US population, yet accounted for almost 1 in 4 (24%) infections in 2014.

Participants at this Reunion Latina will have a chance to understand the Healthcare Needs and the Diversity of Latinos in NYS as well as understand and examine the implementation challenges of *The Plan to End the AIDS Epidemic by 2020*.
